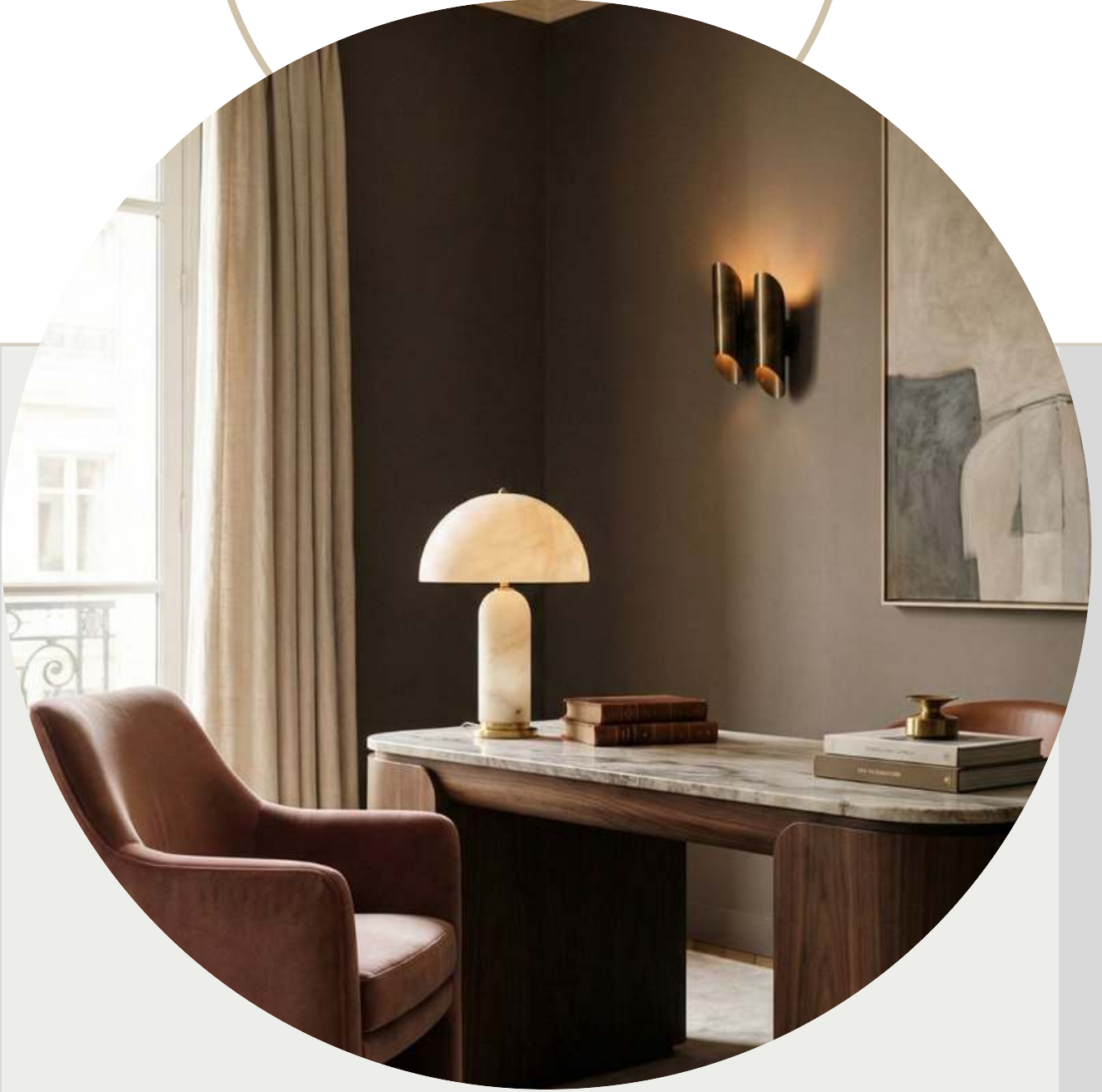

# Work from Home Prompt Playbook

# The Workflow

## **Step 1 – Start with ChatGPT or Claude**

Paste the prompt and ask it to refine or adapt it to your project

## **Step 2 – Clarify Your Direction**

Adjust:

- Colours
- Materials
- Mood
- Use case (client / content / concept)

## **Step 3 – Generate in Nano Banana or in ChatGPT Image Generator**

*You can access Nano Banana in the Gemini app for free*

Paste your refined prompt and generate 3–5 variations

## **Step 4 – Select & Refine**

Choose the strongest direction and tweak details if needed

Most people use AI like a shortcut.

But the best results come from using it as a creative partner.

The prompt is just the starting point.

Your direction is what makes the result feel considered and high-end.

## How to Get Better Results

Tailor your prompt

- Add lighting direction (soft, diffused, window light)
- Be specific with materials (linen, oak, marble – not “neutral tones”)
- Think in compositions, not objects
- Always generate multiple versions

## When to Use These Prompts

Use these prompts to:

- Create client concept visuals
- Build your portfolio
- Generate content for Pinterest or Instagram
- Explore design directions quickly before committing



**Prompt:**

Ultra-luxury feminine home office with a moody yet elegant palette inspired by modern Parisian interiors.

Deep warm grey, soft charcoal, or muted cocoa walls balanced with lighter ceilings and natural light.

## **Prompt**
